## SUGGESTED PACKING LIST

All students are permitted one carry-on bag and one personal item such as a daypack or small handbag. No checked baggage. The maximum dimensions for the carry-on bag are  $55 \times 35 \times 25$  cm or  $21.7 \times 13.8 \times 9.9$  in. For the hand bag, the limits are  $45 \times 36 \times 20$  cm or  $17.7 \times 14.2 \times 7.9$  in.

The importance of packing lightly cannot be overstated. If you're worried about running out of something essential such as shampoo, remember that you can get it abroad. The average high temperatures in Italy in mid-March range from the mid 60s in Rome to the mid/upper 50s in Milan and Venice, with lows in the upper 40s. Layering your clothing works well.
